



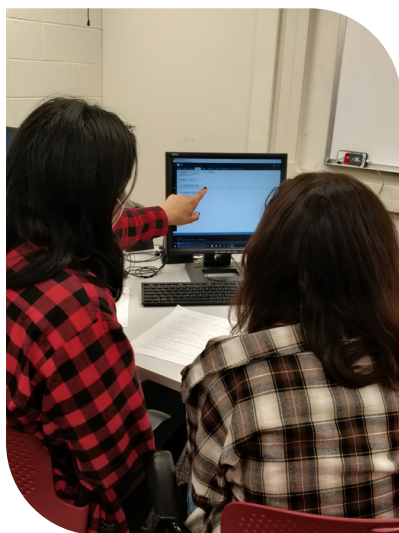

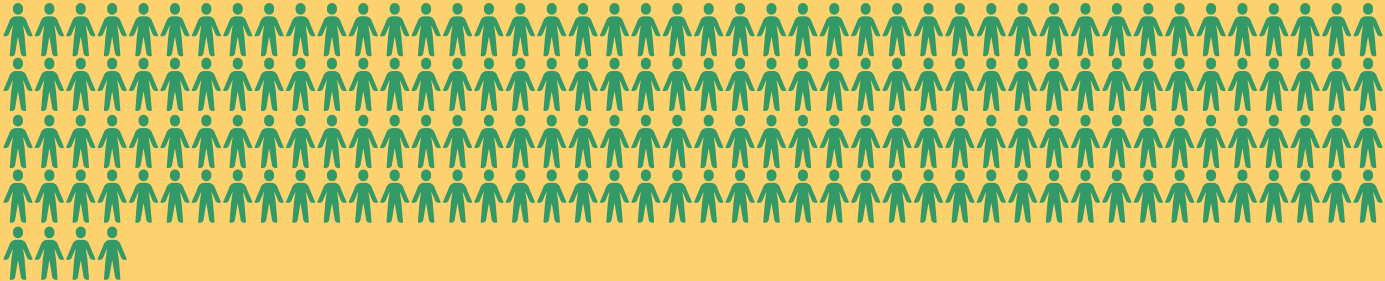

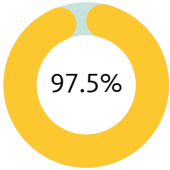


On June 28, 2022,

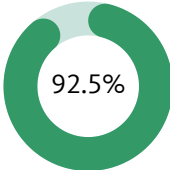
180 youth from across 30 CCE Associations and 2 Cornell groups from NY State and Philadelphia, PA arrived at Cornell University in Ithaca, NY to attend the 100th annual NYS 4-H Career Explorations. Those in 8th grade and older participated in University U, attending a variety of workshops in 6 different departments, and those in 10th grade and older participated in Focus for Teens in a program track of their choice, such as Computer Security, Exploring the Solar System, or Women in Science.



After the completion of the 3 day program,



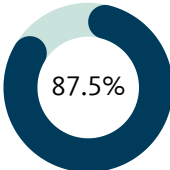

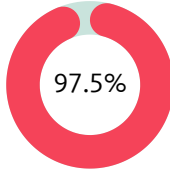
of youth felt Career Explorations was a place where adults cared about them usually or all the time



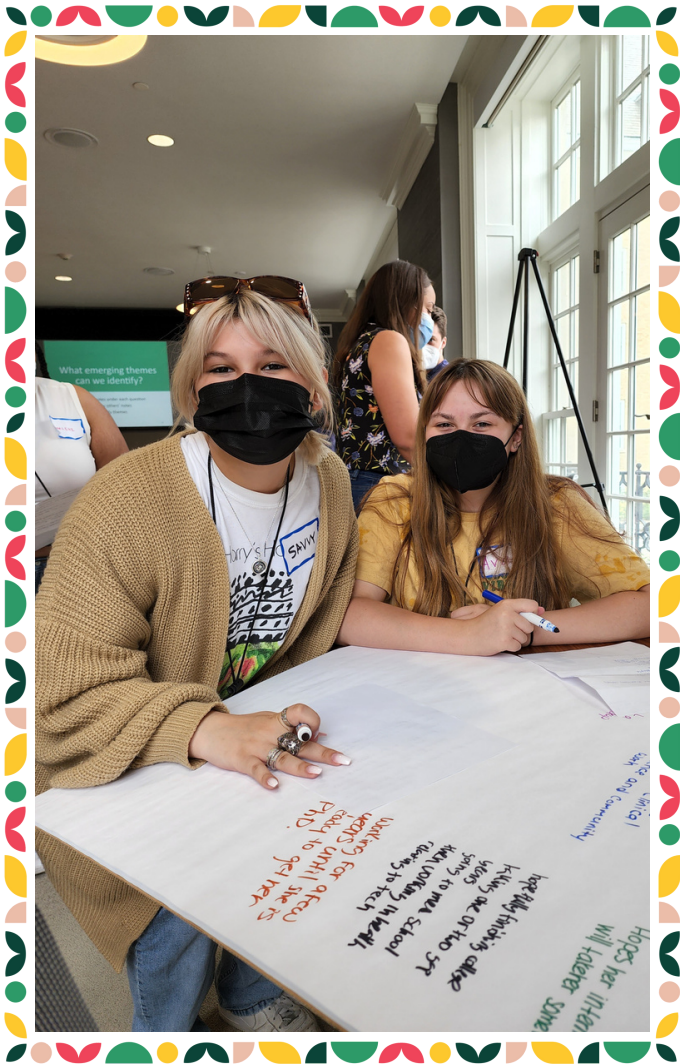
of youth felt Career Explorations was a place where they belonged usually or all the time
